- 3. Agency Reports:

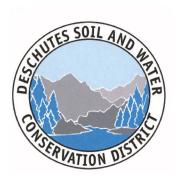
NRCS, Lars Santana

		Richard Winkel has been performing the audit, examining the financials of the district.
		They also assessed for compliance, and they had no findings. Everything appeared to
		be appropriate. Testing has concluded. His recommendations are to develop
		personnel files for all staff and letters of annual raise approvals. He also suggested that
		the District look into an interest bearing checking or savings account.
