## STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES and SOURCES OF FINANCING \*

Deschutes Soil and Water Conservation District (DSWCD) serves all of Deschutes County. The District services promote voluntary efforts to conserve water, protect drinking water supply, improve soil health for local farms and agriculture, support forest health, reduce wildfire risk, enhance fish/wildlife habitat, control invasive weeds, restore streams, and conserve natural areas and green spaces. The District does not make or enforce regulations. The District was approved a permanent rate limit in which the District will levy \$0.06 per \$1,000 assessed value at the November 5, 2024 election. This rate by law cannot be raised. For fiscal year 2025 - 2026, the District will recieve \$2,006,104 through this permanent tax levy. This funding will be received during November 2025. In the interim, DSWCD received a bridge loan of \$750,000 to move the District forward financially until that tax revenue is received. This loan will be paid in full once the tax revenue is received.
